BIPARTISAN APPROVAL OF SCOTT'S HANDLING OF COVID-19 CONTINUES AS CASES RISE IN VERMONT

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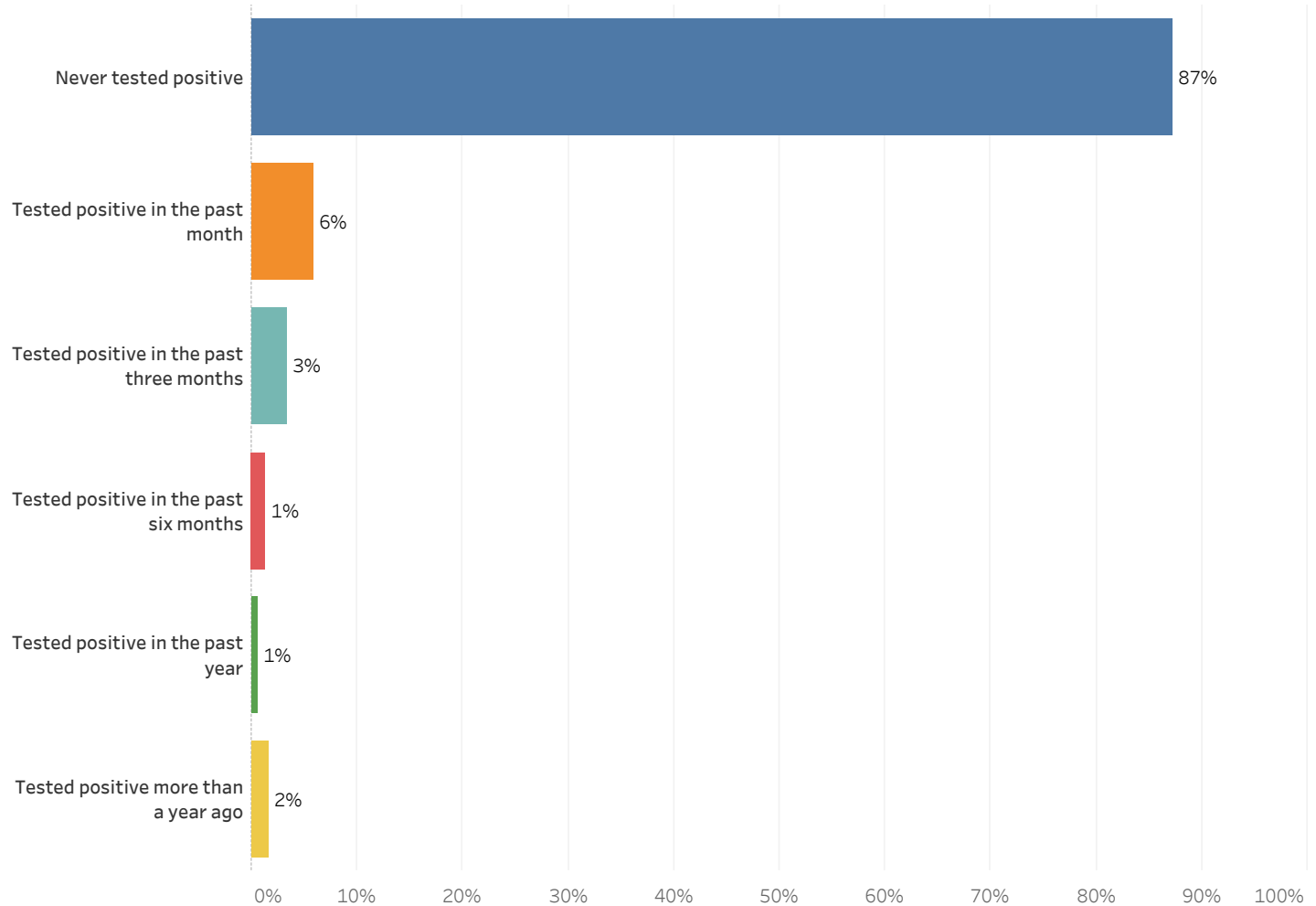
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DURHAM, NH - After nearly two years of the COVID-19 pandemic, one in eight Vermonters report having tested positive for COVID-19 at some point, nearly half of whom say they tested positive in the past month. Seven in ten Vermont residents, and majorities of both Republicans and Democrats, approve of Governor Phil Scott's handling of the pandemic. Few Vermonters say they are comfortable currently going to events with large numbers of people such as a wedding, sporting event, or concert.

COVID-19 Positive Tests

Two years into the pandemic, 13% of Vermont adults say that they have tested positive for COVID-19 at least once; 6% have tested positive in the past month, 3% tested positive in the past three months, 1% tested positive in the past six months, 1% tested positive in the past year, and 2% tested positive more than a year ago. By comparison, 29% of adults in neighboring New Hampshire say they have tested positive for COVID, 13% in the past month.

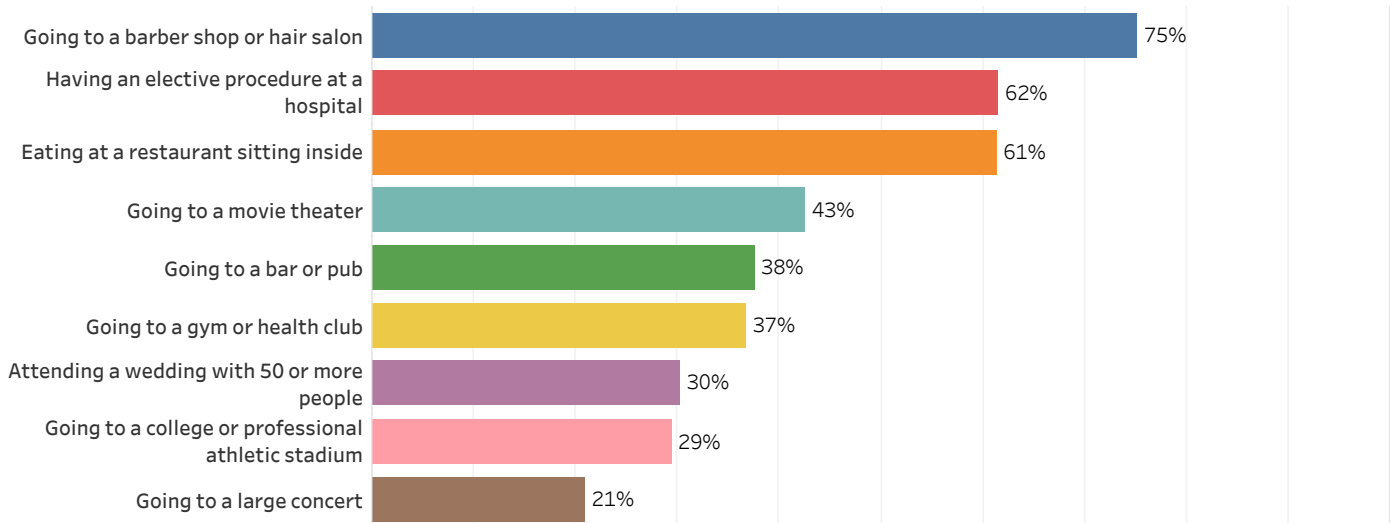
Ever Tested Positive for COVID-19 - January 2022

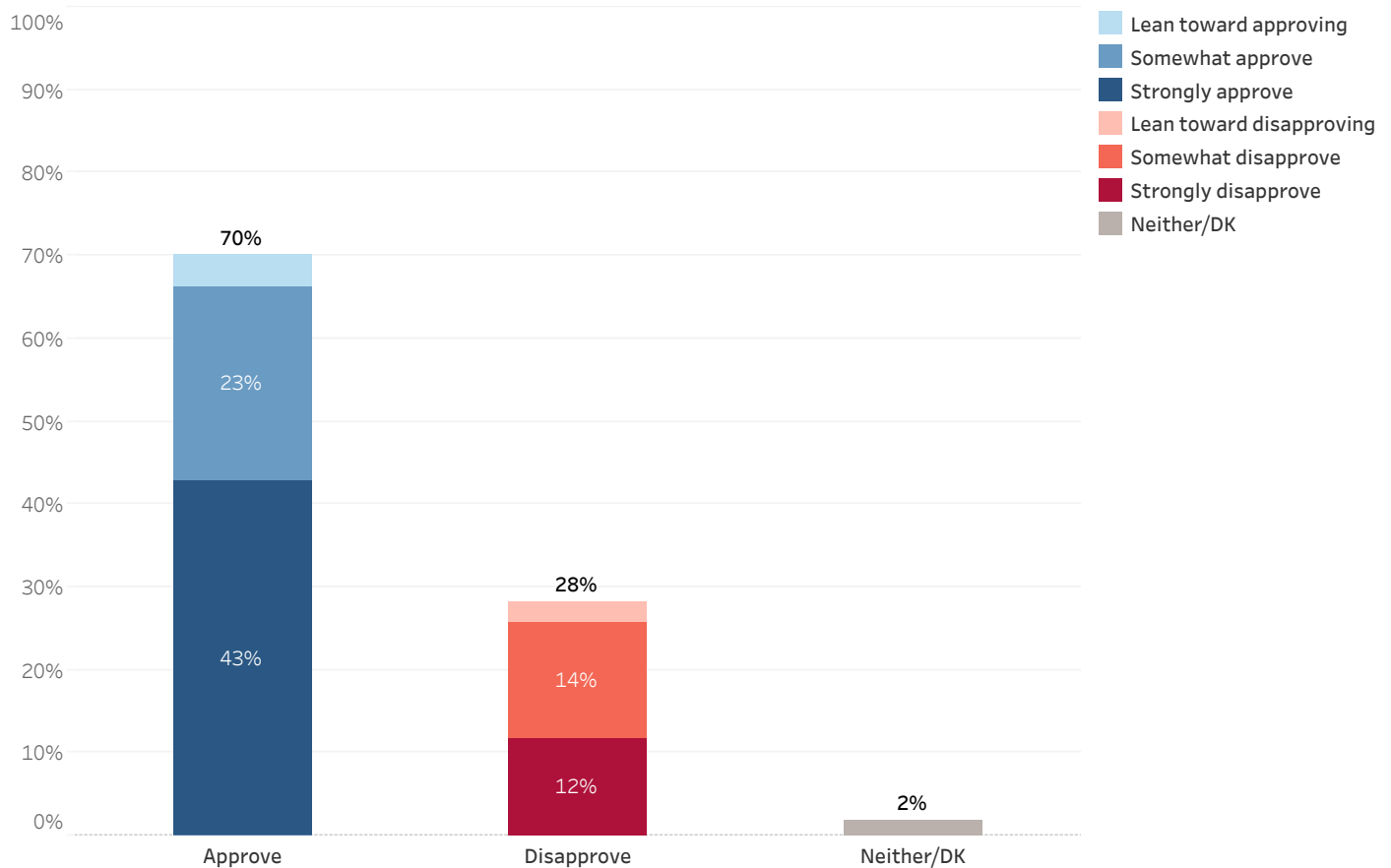
Despite the recent rise in cases, primarily due to the omicron variant, more than half of Vermonters say they are currently comfortable going to a barber shop or hair salon (75%), having an elective procedure at a hospital (62%), or eating at a restaurant sitting inside (61%) while less than half are comfortable going to a movie theater (43%), a bar or pub (38%), or to a gym or health club (37%). Less than a third of Vermonters are comfortable going to a wedding with 50 or more people (30%), a stadium (29%), or a large concert (21%). Self-identified Republicans are considerably more likely than Democrats to be comfortable doing these things.

Governor Phil Scott gets high marks for his handling of COVID - 70% of Vermont adults approve of Governor Scott's handling of the COVID-19 pandemic, 28% disapprove, and 2% neither approve nor disapprove or don't know. Scott's approval is unchanged since November 2021 (69%). Approval of Scott's handling of the pandemic is bipartisan: 76% of Democrats, 67% of Independents, and 63% of Republicans approve of Scott's handling of the pandemic.

Green Mountain State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Green Mountain State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Seven hundred thirty-eight (738) Green Mountain State Panel members completed the survey online between January 20 and January 24, 2022. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.6 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the January 2022 Green Mountain State Poll is 40%. The design effect for the survey is 2.0%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as 2020 election results in Vermont.

The Green Mountain State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of Vermont residents. Approximately 1,900 Vermont adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
